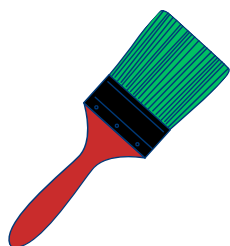
WEEK 3

WHAT PARENTS NEED TO KNOW

The ISG Summer School runs from June 25th to July 19th from 8:30 am to 4:00 pm, Monday through Friday. There is also the option to extend the time to 5 pm. Parents may choose between the 2, 3, or 4-week program - with the possibility of extension if space is available for up to 4 weeks. The program is offered to children aged 2-14 (years of birth: 2021-2010). The program is designed and differentiated based on the different age groups.

DROP OFF

You may drop off your child between 8:10 - 8:30 at the gym. Please call the office if you need to drop off after 9:00 as the doors will be locked.

PICK UP

You may pick up your child at 4:00 pm or 5 pm if you have chosen the after-school extended time
