This year, we invite children to join our ISG Summer School to imagine a world where peace, cooperation, and understanding connect every country. Through the theme Dreaming of World Peace and Unity, students will journey around the globe—without leaving camp—“traveling” each week to a different hemisphere to discover cultures, traditions, languages, and landscapes while learning how shared values unite us.

The program blends arts, storytelling, games, science, and cultural activities to foster curiosity, empathy, and global awareness. Each week begins with a “departure day,” where campers receive a passport and prepare for their adventure, collecting stamps, creating journals, tasting foods, learning dances, and collaborating on projects that celebrate unity across cultures.

WESTERN HEMISPHERE JOURNEY

June 22-26

Campers begin their journey exploring countries across **North** and **South America**, exploring the traditions, music, and cultures that shape the Western Hemisphere.

Activities may include...

- Drumming rhythms
- Traditional story telling
- Team challenges inspired by different cultures

The focus of this week is to establish collaboration, creativity, and a deeper appreciation for **global diversity**.



Week 2

SOUTHERN HEMISPHERE DISCOVERY

June 29-July 3



In week two, campers travel to **South America**, **Southern Africa**, and **Oceania**. Through colorful crafts and outdoor exploration, they will experience the vibrant cultures and natural environments of countries below the equator.

Activities may include...

- Create rainforest art
- Research projects on unique wildlife
- Explore how communities care for their environments

The focus of the week is respect for nature and the connection between **people** and the **planet**.

Week 3

EASTERN HEMISPHERE EXPLORATION

July 6-10

In our third week, campers travel to the **Middle East, Asia, Africa, and Australia**. Children will discover ancient histories, traditional art forms, and unique cultural practices. Activities could include...

- Calligraphy
- Storytelling circles
- Traditional games from different countries

Campers will learn how knowledge, trade, and ideas have traveled across this hemisphere for thousands of years, helping civilizations **grow and connect**.



Week 4

NORTHERN HEMISPHERE ADVENTURE

July 13-17



The final week highlights **Europe, North America, and parts of Asia**. They will learn about famous landmarks, traditional music, and stories from different cultures. Activities might include...

- Building miniature landmarks
- Learning simple greetings in different languages
- Discovering how people celebrate holidays around the world

The week focuses on the idea that even though cultures may look different, many traditions share values like **family, kindness, and community**.

WHAT PARENTS NEED TO KNOW



The ISG Summer School runs from June 22nd to July 17th from 8:30 am to 4:00 pm, Monday through Friday. There is also the option to extend the time to 5 pm. Parents may choose between the 2, 3, or 4 weeks program - with the possibility of extension if space is available for up to 4 weeks. The program is offered to children aged 3-14. The program is designed and differentiated based on the different age groups.

DROP OFF

You may drop off your child between 8:30 am - 8:45 am at the gym. Please note, **students are not permitted before 8:30am and doors will be locked at 9:00am** - Please call the office if you need to drop off after 9:00 am.

PICK UP

You may pick up your child at 3:45 pm or by 5:00 pm if you have chosen the after-school extended time

WHAT TO WEAR

- Athletic clothing (shorts and t-shirts)
- Sturdy outdoor shoes
- Sunscreen (applied before coming to school)

WHAT TO BRING

- A change of clothes
- A snack (a fruit should be washed and cut at home)
- A water bottle with the name of the child
- Bug spray
- Ziplock bag **labeled with the child's name**
- Water clothes, bathing suit and towel
